



Cougar Demographics and Human Interactions along Colorado's Front-range

He will address 6 major cougar research topics: 1) Natural history information, 2) Predator-prey relationships, 3) Population estimation, 4) Appropriate management response levels to human conflict, 5) Relocation of cougars interacting with humans, and 6) Cougar movement patterns relative to cougar demographic and environmental variables. He will also discuss their approaches to this research and some of the initial findings.
