Join veteran bushwhacker Mike MacFerrin as he recounts a month-long, two-year solo crossing of Baranof Island, Alaska via foot and packraft. The most rugged island in the Tongass NF's Alexander Archipelago, Baranof's 1600 square miles harbor countless grizzlies, hanging ice fields, jagged unnamed mountains and some of the world's wildest and most breathtaking temperate rainforests. Mike narrates photos and videos from his record-setting crossing of the island, involving close bear encounters, icefield crossings, lost gear, rogue waves, and running wild rivers through thick, untrammelled valleys.
